DIRECTION: EXAMINING GOD’S HAND IN HISTORY

2 Peter 1:21; 2 Timothy 3:16

Inspiration is the mechanism God used to get his word to us without corruption.

Inspiration and “The Original Writings”

- A. When God's finger touched the tables of stone to write the Ten Commandments
- B. When God's finger touched the plaster-wall of Belshazzar's palace to deliver a sentence of doom
- C. When Jesus Christ stooped down to write in the dust after they brought him the woman taken in adultery

2 Peter 1:21 For the prophecy came not in old time by the will of man: but holy men of God **spake** as they were **moved by the Holy Ghost**.

2 Timothy 3:16 All scripture is **given by inspiration** of God,

Defn.: *Scripture* is the written preservation of verbal communication from God by making it visible in writing; *scripture* is what was written, and then recognized as authoritative.

What Is Your Compass For?

Revelation—God manifesting himself

Inspiration—the manifestation that came down in words

Inscription—those words are recorded in writing

Transmission—that writing is copied for others

Preservation—those copies are providentially protected

Translation—preserved copies are brought into your language

Illumination—the Spirit gives you understanding of that translation

Proverbs 6:23 For the commandment is a lamp; and the law is light; and reproofs of instruction are the way of life:

Psalms 119:105 Thy word is a lamp unto my feet, and a light unto my path.

Isaiah 43:1-2 Fear not: for I have redeemed thee, ... I will be with thee; ... when thou walkest through the fire,

Thesis:

The Reformation led to the discovery of biblical preservation, so that God’s revelation could go through translation and give a new generation God’s inspiration!

The Ideology of Our Theology

- I. There are two seeds that are outwardly similar, but they produce different fruits and results

Proverbs 16:25 There is a way that seemeth right unto a man, but the end thereof are the ways of death.

TWO SEEDS

GOD’S WORD SAYS

Salvation is by atonement
 It is based on divine mercy
 You need a new heart
 Get new life
 It is all done
 Envelop in Christ’s character
 God worked his way to you

MAN’S WAY SAYS

Salvation is by attainment
 It is based on human merit
 You only need a new start
 Turn over a new leaf
 You have to do
 Develop a better character
 You work your way to God
